Matthew 5:13-16 "You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? It is then good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by men. "You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. Genesis 3:7 "Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves coverings.

Genesis 3:10 "So he said, "I heard Your voice in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; and I hid myself." **Genesis 3:11** "And He said, "Who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten from the tree of which I commanded you that you should not eat?"

• Naked: Utterly naked, helpless and shame.

God asked them a question that they never answered. "Who told you that you were naked?"

- **2 Peter 1:16** "For we did not follow cunningly devised fables when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were eyewitnesses of His majesty."
 - We don't trust in a weak promise or fable. The gospel is the very power of God.

Mark 8:38 "For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words in this adulterous and sinful generation, of him the Son of Man also will be ashamed when He comes in the glory of His Father with the holy angels."
